Dress Code

For and in consideration of permitting above-listed minor to observe, or use any facility or equipment of FBC or engage in and/or receive instruction in any activity or activity incidental thereto SOME OF WHICH MAY INVOLVE DANGERS AND RISK OF BODILY INJURY (SUCH AS, BUT ARE NOT LIMITED TO: SNOW PLAY AND ACTIVIES at BONITA PARK in the city of AGNUS, County of LINCOLN, and State of NEW MEXICO, beginning on the day of JAN 12, 2023, the undersigned parent and/or guardian of above- listed minor: hereby voluntarily and absolutely releases, discharges, waives, and relinquishes any and all loss or damages or actions or causes of action for personal injury, property damage, or wrongful death occurring to above-listed minor as a result of above-listed minor's observing or using facilities or equipment of FBC, or engaging in or receiving instructions in any activities SOME OF WHICH MAY INVOLVE DANGERS AND RISK OF BODILY INJURY SUCH AS, BUT ARE NOT LIMITED TO: Snow play, high ropes, zipline, swimming, climbing, hiking, sports or in activities incidental thereto wherever or however the same may occur, and for whatever period said activities or instructions may continue. The undersigned parent or guardian of above-listed minor for him/herself, his/her heirs, executors, administrators, or assigns agrees that in the event any claim for personal injury, property damage, or wrongful death shall be prosecuted against FBC or its officers, agents, servants, or employees, the undersigned parent or guardian will indemnify and hold harmless FBC and its officers, agents, servants, or employees from any and all claims or causes of action by above-listed minor or by any other person or entity, by whomever or wherever made or presented, and under no circumstances will the undersigned parent or guardian of above-listed minor present any claim against FBC and said persons for personal injuries, property damage, wrongful death, or otherwise, caused by any act of negligence by FBC and said persons.

The undersigned parent or guardian represent that he/she has read this Release, has requested and has been provided with, or has requested and declined advisement on the potential dangers/risks of engaging in the observation, activities, or instruction offered, assumes all risks associated with such dangers and risks, and is fully aware of and understands the terms and the legal consequences of the signing of this Release. The undersigned parent or legal guardian intends his or her signature to be a complete and unconditional release of all liability to the greatest extent allowed by law and if any portion of the Release is held invalid, it is agreed that the balance shall, notwithstanding, continue in full legal force and effect.
